I understand that:
 An Ad Hoc Technical Selection Committee will review all the candidatures received and submit its recommendations for the composition of the Steering Committee to the CFS Bureau for decision. Steering Committee members are appointed for a mandate of two years (starting October 2025, ending October 2027), renewable consecutively only once. Steering Committee members contribute to the work of the HLPE-FSN in their individual capacities, not
 as representatives of their respective governments, institutions or organizations. Steering Committee members are expected to dedicate a substantial amount of their time to the HLPE-FSN: at least 20 days per year, travel included (at least 40 days for the Chairperson and the Vice-Chairperson).
 Steering Committee members <u>are not compensated</u> for their work in the HLPE-FSN. Each year, Steering Committee members are expected to participate in two three-day meetings organized in different regions of the world. The first meeting will take place in Rome in November 2025 (to be confirmed). Travel expenses will be covered by the HLPE-FSN.
